IMPORTANT: Note that all documents for attestation or legalization must be already attested by the Indian Ministry of Foreign Affairs

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ATTESTATION / LEGALIZATION OF PERSONAL DOCUMENTS

- 1 A Miscellaneous application form duly filled in and signed (available on BLS website) ☐
- 2 Original and self-attested photocopy of passport (first and last page) ☐
- 3 Original and self-attested photocopy of Spanish resident card ☐
- 4 Original documents to be attested along with photocopy ☐
 - Fees will be charged as per the number of documents to be attested or legalized
 - Attestation by Indian Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be over than 3 months old in case of PCC, and over 6 months old in case of Birth Certificate/Marriage certificate
 - Documents in Spanish must first be translated to English (by an official translator) and then attested by the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- 5 Declaration form: to be filled by all applicants when submitting any application ☐

In case the applicant is a minor, original & self-attested photocopies of parents' passports and resident cards should be provided

Note: If the applicant/applicant's family member/ relative holds Spanish nationality, they must provide a Surrender Certificate or OCI (including the endorsement page) with the application.
