- 3 Original and self-attested photocopy of passport (first and last pages) ☐
- 4 Original and self-attested photocopy of resident card. In case applicant is not holding a resident card, Empadronamiento and English translation is required. ☐
- 5 A letter from the civil registry of the Spanish Principalities/States concerned (or their requirements) asking for such conduct certificate to be issued by the Embassy ☐
- 6 Declaration form : to be filled in by all applicants when submitting any application ☐

Note: If the applicant/applicant's family member/ relative holds Spanish nationality, they must provide a Surrender Certificate or OCI (including the endorsement page) with the application.

In case the applicant is a minor, original & self-attested photocopies of parents' passports and resident cards should be provided
