## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ATTESTATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

- 1 A Miscellaneous application form duly filled in and signed (available on BLS website). ☐
- 2 Documents to be attested in original along with one photocopy. The deponent/applicant will have to Sign the document in the presence of the Consular Officer of the Embassy. ☐
- 3 Passport in original with a self-attested copy. ☐
- 4 Residence card in original with a self-attested copy. (In case applicant doesn't have residence card, latest "empadronamiento" is required with English translation). ☐
- 5 Declaration form: to be filled by all applicants when submitting any application. ☐
- 6 One photograph is required for Power of Attorney. ☐

In case the applicant is a minor, original & self-attested photocopies of parents' passports and resident cards should be provided

Note: If the applicant/applicant's family member/ relative holds Spanish nationality, they must provide a Surrender Certificate or OCI (including the endorsement page) with the application.
