## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A JOURNALIST VISA

- 1 Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having ☐ at least 2 blank visa pages and copy
- 2 Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our ☐ website
  - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 (online form link: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/index.html>) ☐
- 4 A letter from your employer stating the purpose of your visit and duration of stay in India. This letter should be written on company letterhead and in English ☐
- 5 Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application ☐
- 6 Additional documents mentioned below as per your case ☐

## LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

### If the applicant is not holding a Spanish passport

- Registration Certificate from the concern City Council/Municipal (minimum period of stay in Spain is 2 years), with an issue date which should not exceed 180 days. ☐
- Referral form duly filled in Capital Letters ☐

### If the applicant obtained Spanish nationality by naturalization and previously held Bangladeshi, Pakistani or Sri Lankan nationality

- Literal Birth certificate. (Certificación literal de nacimiento) ☐
- Nationality certificate proving when Spanish nationality was obtained ☐

### If the applicant will participate in the filming of a documentary or commercial in India
